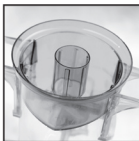


Feeder Features

- The feeder comes with port inserts that let you Choose Your Birds. The feeder comes assembled with hooded inserts to dispense Sunflower or Mixed Seed. Included is a small bag that contains inserts to convert the feeder to dispense Thistle/Nyjer Seed. Make sure your feeder is empty before switching types to avoid spilling seed
- To fill, slide up feeder roof
- To clean ports and base of feeder, unscrew the Phillip's head screw inside the ports and lift tube off base
- Durable polycarbonate construction

Feeder Cleaning Tips - Wear rubber gloves while cleaning feeders

- Clean your seed feeder at least once a month. More often if you have flocks of birds at your feeder constantly.
- In most cases, simply wash your feeder with warm water. If extra cleaning is required, use a mix of 1 part bleach to 10 parts warm water.
If no bleach is available, a mild dish washing detergent can be used. You can also use a cleaning brush such as the #38293 brush kit. Do not use steel wool or abrasive metal brushes as these can damage feeders.
- After cleaning, rinse thoroughly and make sure your clean feeder is completely dry before refilling with your favorite seed.
- Clean the area below your feeder. Remove old seed debris from underneath your feeder on a regular basis for a healthier feeder location.

HOW TO INSTALL THE THISTLE/NYJER® INSERT

1. Make sure the feeder is empty and determine what kind of seed you want to serve. The feeder comes ready to fill with mixed or sunflower seed. To adjust the main ports to serve thistle/Nyjer® seed, simply remove the seed ports by inserting your finger into the main ports and pulling out until it's free from the tube. Next, snap the thistle/Nyjer® inserts into the main ports from outside of the feeder.
2. To convert the feeder back to a mixed or sunflower seed feeder, push the bottom of the insert with your thumb until it pops out. Or, open the feeder and push the insert with your finger from behind until it pops out.
